

In 1983 a group of classical musicians, led by conductor Wayne Reinecke, made their dream a reality by founding Pasadena Community Orchestra. Initially performing at First United Methodist Church in Pasadena, the orchestra moved their venue to First Church of the Nazarene in 1987, where they continue to perform today. In 2007, conductor Wayne Reinecke retired and his son Alan was selected to replace him. In July 2013, Bethany Pflueger assumed the mantle of Musical Director of PCO. This will be her fourth year at the podium.

The vision of PCO has consistently been to bring beautiful music to the community, free of charge. The orchestra continues its strong commitment to music education programming through the Young Artist Competition and Concert in May, and ends the season with a celebratory Concert in Sierra Madre's Memorial Park in June.
